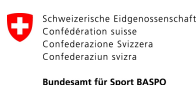


Organizational directives field season 2023/2024

OUR PARTNERS



- **Rules Art. 23.2.: Amendment**

Participation of juniors in championships: Eligibility to play in the various categories:

Category	U15	Youth	Active*	NLB Women	Seniors
Participation	from the 10th birthday	from the age of 13	from the age of 15	from the age of 14	from the age of 33

* see also Article 22.3 of the Rules of the Game (see below)

- **Rules Art. 22.3.: Clarification**

Participation of clubs in championships: only women over their 18th birthday may play in the men's 1st league.

- **Junior Regulations Art. 3.1.6.: Amendment**

Change mode & playing times U15 and U15 girls: Individual matches will be played in these categories, playing time is 4 x 15min.

- **Rules Art. 39.1.: Clarification**

In official championship matches of all leagues, time is not stopped (no time stop) for short corners and after goals, with the exception of the Final 4 NLA women and men.

- **Rules Art. 30.4.b.: Amendment**

Re-qualifications of players for the women's field championship NLA must now be made at least one week before the start of the 1st game of the own club in the second half of the season.

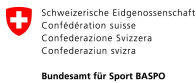
- **Reporting Results: Clarification**

Results of the NLA games must be entered online in Clubee directly after the end of the game. For all other leagues including juniors until 8pm.

- **Seasons on the last matchday of the NLA Women and Men: Clarification**

In the last round with regular championship games (not Final4) of the NLA women and men, all games within a league will be scheduled on the same day and at the same time. The kick-off times are determined by the office and cannot be changed by the clubs.

- **Rules Art. 38.1 - 38.5: Clarification**

The players and coaches must be listed in the digital match report in the Clubee system before the start of the game. Immediately after the end of the match, the electronic match report sheet is digitally signed by the referees.

For U12, there is no need to for complete match reports, only the results must be written in the system.

- **Rules of the Game Art. 34: Supplement**

If a player gets are 3 yellow cards, there will be a ban for 1 match. The ban always applies in the next game in the highest league in which the player has played.

- **Mode NLA Master and Challenge: Change**

Relegation/Promotion: After each of the 3 rounds, the last-placed team of the NLA Masters is relegated to the NLA Challenge and is replaced by the first-placed team of the NLA Challenge of the respective round.

After the third round, the top 6 ranked teams of the NLA Masters will qualify for the NLA Masters of the coming season. Plus the first-placed team of the third round of the NLA Challenge of the current season.
