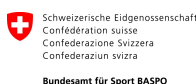


Organizational directives outdoor season 2024/2025

Unsere Partner:



- **Mode and playing times: Clarification**

For all leagues, the specifications regarding modes and playing times as described in the document “240817_Mode Field 2024-2025.pdf” apply.

- **Game regulations Art. 23.2: Clarification**

Participation of juniors in championships: Eligibility to play in the various categories:

Categorie	U15	U18	Aktive *	NLB-Women	Master
Participation	From 10th birthday	From 13th birthday	From 15th birthday	From 14th birthday	From 33th birthday

* See also the applicable Article 22.3 of the Playing Rules (see below)

- **Playing regulations Art. 22.3: Clarification**

In the 1st division, female players may only be fielded on their 18th birthday.

- **Game regulations Art. 27.2: Clarification**

New licences and renewals of licences that have not been activated in the meantime must be applied for no later than 3 days before the first championship match for the indoor championship, or by 31 March for the spring season of the field championship, so that the licence holders are eligible to play in the highest leagues of the women (NLA) and men (NLA Indoor, NLA Master and NLA Challenge).

- **Rules of the Game Art. 30.4.b.: Amendment**

Requalification's of players for the NLA women's field championship must be made at least one week before the start of the second round.

- **Art. 34: Amendment**

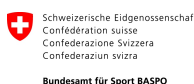
After receiving three yellow cards, the penalized player receives a one match suspension, which must be served in the highest league in which he/she has played in the current season. Important: yellow cards apply across all leagues.

- **Match reports: Replaces Art. 38. of the Laws of the Game**

The players and coaches are recorded in the match report online in the club system before the start of the match. Immediately after the end of the match, the electronic match report sheet is completed and digitally signed by the referees.

For U12s, only the results need to be recorded digitally, not complete match reports.

- **Reporting the results: Clarification**

Results of NLA matches must be entered online in Clubee up to one hour after the end of the match. For all other leagues, including juniors, the match day is until 8pm.

- **Game regulations Art. 39.1: Clarification**

The playing time for the preparation of short corners and after goals is only stopped for the NLA women's and men's Final4 games; however, this does not apply to all other official Swiss Hockey championship games (no time stop).

- **Playing times on the last match day of the NLA women's and men's competitions: Clarification**

In the last round of regular championship games (not Final4) of the NLA women's and men's leagues, all games within a league are scheduled on the same day and at the same time. The kick-off times are determined by the office and cannot be changed by the clubs.
