### Mode Information for the Leagues of the Seniors

Swiss Hockey organizes for the indoor season 2024/2025 with the following leagues for active players:

- Women's NLA

- Men's NLA
- Men's NLB

For the 2024/2025 indoor season, the following guidelines and modes apply.  
IMPORTANT: Requalification's are not possible in the hall.



**NLA Women**      Participant: 6 teams

Playing time: 4 x 10 min

Game mode: Double round followed by the Final4 tournament; the Final4 tournament takes place over a weekend:

- first day:      Semi-finals in cross mode: 1st against 4th, 2nd against 3rd.

- second day:    Match for 3rd place, final for the Swiss championship title

Relegation: The last-placed team will be relegated to the NLB Women; there will be no playoff.

European Cup: The champion participates in the European Cup.

**NLB Women**      Participant: 6 teams

Playing time: 4 x 10 min

Game mode: Double round, everyone against each other; the final ranking will be drawn up according to the standings after the last matchday.

Promotion: The winner of the NLB Women will be promoted to the NLA Women.



## NLA Men

Participant: 6 teams

Playing time: 4 x 10 min

Game mode: Double round followed by the Final4 tournament; the Final4 tournament takes place over a weekend:

- first day: Semi-finals in cross mode: 1st against 4th, 2nd against 3rd.

- second day: Match for 3rd place, final for the Swiss championship title

Relegation: The last-placed team is relegated to the NLB Men. There will be no playoff.

European Cup: The champion participates in the European Cup.

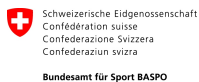
## NLB Men

Participant: 6 teams

Playing time: 4 x 10 min

Game mode: Double round, everyone against each other; the final ranking will be drawn up according to the standings after the last matchday.

Promotion/Relegation: The top-ranked team in the final ranking will be promoted to the NLA, up to the third-placed team. The bottom of the table is relegated to the 1st League Men.

Participant: 7 teams

Playing time: 2 x 15min

Game Mode: Single round each against on three tournaments. The winner of the 1st League Men will be promoted to the NLB Men. Final ranking according to the standings after the last matchday.

## Veterans

Indoor championship tournament on a match weekend with two match days; is organized by the Senior Commission.

### **U18 Elite**

Participant: 12 teams

Playing time: 2 x 15 min; 2 or 3 games per day

Game mode: Preliminary round: 3 groups (A-C) with 4 teams each, each against each other, on 1 tournament day. The top two finishers in each group will form a new 6-team Group D, while the 3rd and 4th-placed teams will form a 6-team Group E.

In the two groups of 6 D and E, everyone plays against each other, spread over 3 tournament days. On the third day of the tournament, the finals will take place: 5th against 6th, 3rd against 4th, and 1st against 2nd.

The winner of the match 1st against 2nd of Group D is Swiss champion of the U18 Elite age group.

### **U18 Challenge**

Will not be held in the 2024/25 indoor season.

### **U18 Girls**

Participant: 3 teams

Playing time: 2 x 15 min; 2 or 3 games per day

Game mode: Double round played over 2 tournament days. The top two teams will play a final on the second day of the tournament.

### **U15 Elite**

Participant: 12 teams

Playing time: 2 x 15 min; 2 or 3 games per day

Game mode: Preliminary round: 3 groups (A-C) with 4 teams each, each against each other, on 2 tournament days. The top two finishers in each group will form a new 6-team Group D, while the 3rd and 4th-placed teams will form a 6-team Group E.

In the two groups of 6 D and E, everyone plays against each other, spread over 3 tournament days. On the third day of the tournament, the finals will take place: 5th against 6th, 3rd against 4th, and 1st against 2nd.

The winner of the match 1st against 2nd of Group D is Swiss champion of the U15 Elite age group.

Participant: 8 teams

Playing time: 2 x 15 min; 2 or 3 games per day

Game mode: Single round on 3 match days + Final 4

Game mode: Double round played over 2 tournament days + Final 4

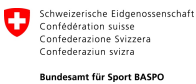
**U12**

**Important:** No Swiss champion will be played in the U12

**U12 Girls**

Participant: 4 teams

Playing time: 2 x 10 min, 2 tournament match days, 3 games per day

Game mode: Two tournaments each against each other. Additional tournaments can be organized through the Hockey Kids Tool.

**Important:** in the U12 Girls there will be no Swiss Champion
