1. General information

We treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the statutory data protection regulations of Switzerland (Federal Data Protection Act (DSG)), the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) where applicable, and this data protection declaration. With this declaration we inform you about how we collect, process and use your data.

3. Collection and processing of personal data

We only collect and process personal data if this is permitted by law or if you have given your express consent.

3.1 access data

When you visit our website, the following data is automatically collected by our IT systems:

- your IP address
- date and time of access
- Name and URL of the retrieved file
- Website from which access is made (referrer URL)
- browser type and operating system

This data is used exclusively to ensure the smooth operation of the website and to improve our offering and does not allow us to draw any direct conclusions about you personally.

3.3 Personal data

4. Purposes of use

We use your personal data exclusively for the following purposes:

- Licensing and registration of athletes and members
- provision and optimization of our digital offerings
- Communication with you, especially to process inquiries
- Sending information about Swiss Hockey and our events
- provision and billing of services
- compliance with legal obligations

5. Transfer of data to third parties

Your personal data will generally not be passed on to third parties unless:

- You have expressly consented
- the transfer is necessary to process a contract,
- we are legally obliged to do so, or
- We commission external service providers to process the data, whom we carefully select and contractually bind.
